The 2018 Municipal/School Board Elections will be held this October in the City of Quinte West.

Voter Notification Packages

Voter notification packages will be mailed to electors, whose name appeared on the voter's list, during the 3rd week of September advising of voting hours, locations and alternative voting methods. If you do not receive a voter notification mailing please contact the City Clerk's office at 613-392-2841.

Internet Voting - October 1st - 21st, 2018

Internet Voting will commence Monday, October 1, 2018 at 10:00am through Sunday, October 21, 2018 at 11:59pm. Voters must register on-line and receive a PIN prior to voting. Visit the City's website to view a video of how the process works.

Advance Voting - Saturday, October 13, 2018

Paper ballot advance voting will be held Saturday, October 13, 2018. Voting hours will be 10:00am to 8:00pm. Electors must have identification in order to vote.

Advance Voting is "VOTE ANYWHERE" within the municipality and electors may choose to vote at any of the 4 locations noted below:

- City Hall - 7 Creswell Drive, Trenton
- Centennial Hall - 1620 Wallbridge-Loyalist Road (Tuckers Corners)
- Lower Trent Conservation Office - 714 Murray Street (South of Wooler)
- Frankford Lion's Centre - 50 Centre Street, Frankford

Election Day - Monday, October 22, 2018

There are 13 voting locations established within the City of Quinte West. Electors will be notified in their voter notification package of their designated voting location. Electors must have identification in order to vote. Voting hours will be 10:00am to 8:00pm.

Proxy Voting

An eligible elector may appoint another eligible elector as a voting proxy. Completed applications must be presented in person by the person appointed as the voting proxy, at the City Clerk's Office located at 7 Creswell Drive, Trenton, during normal office hours. Please call 613-392-2841 before you attend at the Clerk's Office to ensure an election official is available to certify the application. The last day for making application for a certificate to vote by proxy on behalf of another elector is Monday, October 22, 2018, no later than 4:30 pm.
